

Greater Victoria CUPE Scholarship Award Application Form for 2026

Use this form to apply for an award if you will be registered for courses at an accredited public or private post-secondary educational, vocational, or career training institution, anywhere in the world, for the academic year of 2026-2027.

Who is eligible to apply?

1. Student is currently an active member of a Greater Victoria CUPE local that participates in the scholarship fund. Participating locals are

CUPE 788
CUPE 917
CUPE 951
CUPE 2011
CUPE 2081
2. Student is registered for full-time or part-time studies.
3. Student has not previously been awarded a scholarship from this committee.

What do I need to send with this application?

1. A letter introducing yourself. You may want to include your achievements, educational goals, employment aspirations, community involvement, obstacles you have had to overcome, etc. Tell the committee why a scholarship should be awarded to you. Maximum 500 words, typed, double spaced.
2. Copy of your transcripts from your most recently completed academic term. These can be from high school, college, university, or a combination of these. **Transcripts must be scanned, no screenshots please.**
3. Proof of registration the 2026-2027 academic year. Proof of admission/acceptance is **not** proof of registration and will not be accepted.
4. One reference letter from a non-family member. The letter should be written specifically to support your application for this scholarship. Must include the referee's name, contact information and date.

How are awards determined?

The Greater Victoria CUPE Scholarships will be awarded based on a combination of course transcripts, the personal letter, and the letter of reference. The Greater Victoria CUPE Scholarship Committee reserves the right to verify application information. This includes, but is not limited to, communicating with any person providing a support document for this application. All applications will be dealt with in the strictest confidence and will be securely destroyed after the awards are distributed. By signing the application, the student agrees with the terms of this scholarship.

Completed applications *must be received by*
October 15, 2026.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. I have a photocopy of my official transcripts; can I use that instead of ordering a new official copy?

Yes. Photocopies are acceptable. Please scan the photocopy and upload it as part of your application

2. Can I give my application to my local's scholarship committee member?

No. All applications must be emailed to gvcupescholarshipcommittee@gmail.com

3. Can I drop my application off in person?

No. All applications must be emailed to gvcupescholarshipcommittee@gmail.com

4. What if I am not the biological child of the CUPE member?

This award is designed to financially assist CUPE members with the expenses involved in supporting a child/employee through post-secondary education. If you are a CUPE member or child of a CUPE member and the other eligibility requirements are met, then you can apply. If you need further clarification, please contact one of the GV CUPE scholarship committee representatives.

5. How much is the award?

The amount of the award varies based on contributions from participating CUPE locals.

6. How does the scholarship committee determine who shall receive an award?

The award recipients are determined based on a number of combined factors: your transcripts, your introduction letter, and your reference letter. You will be at a disadvantage if your application does not include each of these items. The committee strives to award at least one student from each of the participating locals. When there are no applicants from one or more of the participating locals, the committee will choose from the greater applicant pool.

7. When will I find out if I am receiving a scholarship award? The scholarship committee meets in December to review applications and to determine the award recipients. The committee will advise all applicants whether or not they will receive an award. Cheques are typically mailed out late December.

8. I was not awarded a scholarship and would like to appeal the committee's decision. How do I do that? All of the committee's decisions are final and there is no appeal process. This scholarship is awarded competitively, and the competition can be close. If you remain eligible in future years, you are welcome to apply again.

9. I have received a scholarship from this committee in the past. Can I apply again?

No. If you have previously been awarded a scholarship from this committee, you are not eligible to apply again.
